

ASAM New Petition Process

Petitioners must submit to the Nominations & Awards Council the same information (*Disclosure of Interests & Affiliations*) required of all candidates forty-five (45) days before the Med-Sci Conference. List of petitioning candidates will be provided to all registering ASAM members near the ASAM registration desk so that members can decide whether or not to sign a petition of a petitioning candidate. To satisfy the requirement to be placed on the ballot and to participate in the ASAM approved campaigning process, a petitioning candidate would be required to obtain 100 signatures of ASAM active members by 12:00 noon the day of the ASAM-approved “Meet the Candidates Forum.”

ASAM Campaign Guidelines prohibits written or electronic communication campaigning, restricted or unrestricted either by the candidates or by the advocates for the candidates.

All nominated or petitioning candidates will have the opportunity to provide the membership with their vision and to answer questions at the “Meet the Candidates Forum” on Friday, April 11th in Toronto at 8:30 pm.
