#### Medical Director/Primary Physician for Montana Chemical Dependency Center

This is a highly challenging, fast paced and rewarding opportunity to serve a specialized population of Montana residents. MCDC is a 76 bed Montana State facility located in Butte, providing in-patient, sub-acute care for addictions and co-occurring addictions and psychiatric disorders. The general duties of this position include: managing the general physical health care of all patients; providing history and physicals at the time of admission; managing detoxification for the full range of addictions; evaluating and managing patient medical requests and crisis situations; must have the ability to identify and manage psychiatric disorders and appropriate medication regimes; ability to be a strong team player with a diversified staff of professionals; experience in participating on management team; certified by the American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM) with specialized prescriptive authority for the administration of buprenorphine (Suboxone) or willing to achieve this status; must be skilled in computer use to enter all information into an electronic medical record; willing to provide on-call services.
