The ASAM Treatment of Opioid Use Disorder Course covers all medications and treatments for opioid use disorder, and provides eight hours of required education needed to obtain the waiver to prescribe buprenorphine. The course format combines four hours of self-paced online learning with four hours of live learning for a total of eight hours. The online portion is expected to be completed first as it covers essential knowledge content. The live portion will focus on the clinical application of the content covered online using case-based discussions. ASAM is an approved provider by CSAT/SAMHSA of DATA 2000 training. ASAM also provides the additional 16 hours for NPs and PAs at no charge.
